



SPRING CHECKLIST: Electric

- Check that smoke and carbon monoxide detectors are in working order. Recommend replacing batteries if you haven't recently.
- If you have an older thermostat, replace it with a programmable unit to save on heating costs.
- Check your electrical outlets for potential fire hazards such as frayed wires or loose-fitting plugs. Make sure outlets, fuse boxes and extension cords are not overloaded.
- Clean, pack, and store humidifiers.
- Check your water heater for leaks and corrosion.
- Clean the clothes dryer exhaust duct and space under the dryer. Remove all lint, dust, and pieces of material.
- Replace all high-intensity bulbs with fluorescent bulbs. Other types of bulbs, like incandescent, produce more heat than fluorescent bulbs.
